Migrants from Vientiane first arrived in Thailand during the Rama III period after the Anouvong rebels were suppressed in 1828. Traveling south, one group eventually settled in the country's Uttaradit province, bringing with them their distinct Lao Vieng culture. At Had Song Kwai, you can experience this blend of lifestyle that has been kept mostly the same for over 100 years. Tuck into Thai-Laos food, participate in traditional craft, fabric and cooking workshops and join the locals as they make offerings to the monks as part of an early morning alms-giving ceremony.



## ACTIVITIES

- Experience the lifestyle of Lao Wiang people.
- Make some snacks from bananas like sweet banana chips.
- Sew and screen patterns on eco-friendly fabric bags.
- Make mud-yom fabrics and design your own patterns.
- Cook up some traditional Lao Wiang dishes with the locals.
- Make rattan carrying racks and recycled brooms.
- Learn how to sing and play Thai 'long drums'.

# PROGRAM 3 DAYS 2 NIGHTS

## DAY 1

- 08.10 am. Welcome the travelling team from Bangkok from flight DD8302 at the arrival terminal, Chiang Mai International Airport and transfer to Laowiang Community, Had Song Kwaie, Uttaradit Province  
Breakfast is served on the way to Uttaradit
- 10.00 am. Visit the Thai Elephant Conservation Center, Lampang Province
- 12.00 pm. Lunch nearby the famous Wat Phra That Lampang Luang and then visit this temple after
- 01.30 pm. Leave for Laos Viang Community in the neighboring Uttaradit Province
- 04.30 pm. Arrive at the Laos Viang Community, Hat Song Kwaie, Uttaradit Province and receive a warm welcome with beautiful garlands and herbal drinks

- 06.00 pm. Dinner at the homestay

- 06.00 am. Alms-giving and merit-making at the Culture Street, Laos Viang Community, Hat Song Kwaie
- 08.00 am. Experience the local way of life and breakfast with the local people at Hat Song Kwaie Temple
- 09.00 am. Learn about handicrafts of the community: Cloth bags, which you can try making yourself for something to bring back home as a souvenir
- 12.00 pm. Lunch at the homestay
- 01.00 pm. Make local dishes such as Thai stuffed peppers and Thai pancakes
- 04.00 pm. Leisure time
- 06.00 pm. Dinner at the homestay

- 06.00 am. Alms-giving and merit-making at the Culture Street, Laos Viang Community, Hat Song Kwaie
- 07.00 am. Breakfast the homestay
- 09.00 am. “Baai Sri Su Kwan” ceremony for friendship between the local people and the travelling group
- 11.00 am. Lunch with the community before leaving
- 02.00 pm. Bid farewell to Laos Viang Community and head to Phitsanulok Airport
- 03.15 pm. Return to Don Muang International Airport Bangkok with Nok Air, flight DD8407
